Campers Checklist

MEALS

All food is provided by the club and is included in the camp fee. We have staff going out specifically to cook so the group staff will be with their group at all times. If the campers want any munchies or extra food, they can bring their own, but it will stay in the kitchen and handed out by staff. Staff are assigned to each cabin group and will be sleeping in the cabins with the members.
